CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The White China stall is a fund raising initiative held at the Annual Exhibition where members (and non-members) can sell unwanted 2nd hand WHITE CHINA, BOOKS, STUDIES, TOOLS, BOXES, PAINT & BRUSHES and any other porcelain art equipment. Strictly NO hand painted china or anything partially decorated. All items must be in good condition and **CLEAN**.

The Guild will deduct 25% commission from sales.

Members can enter free of charge but non-members must be sponsored by a financial member and pay a \$5 handling fee which can be paid on entry or deducted from their sales.

Entries must be listed on an official form.

Price in WHOLE DOLLARS please – no cents. **\$1 MINIMUM PRICE** Bundle lesser priced items together and round off to nearest dollar. Zip lock bags are ideal for phials of paint, brushes, tools and small items.

Each piece must be LABELED & PRICED using your initials in front of a number. Start from Number 1... (eg...**HT1 \$15...HT2 \$3...etc**) Download extra forms as required.

Use LARGE white stickers where possible so they can be seen clearly.

Pack all your White China Sales pieces in an open cardboard box or crate WITH YOUR NAME ON (at both ends please) in BIG LETTERS as these will be stored under the table.

Deliver to the White China Stall at the Exhibition Set Up & collect unsold items at the end of the exhibition. Your list of sold items will be handed into the Treasurer who will send you a cheque for your sales, less commission.

Your pieces will NOT be checked in. Just hand the box to the person at the stall or leave it on the table. **Do not unpack your items**. Pieces will be sold for whatever price they are marked at so please check your own work before delivery.

Exhibition SET UP and TAKE DOWN dates and times are listed in the GUILD NEWSLETTER.

DO NOT SEND THIS ENTRY FORM IN with other Exhibition entry forms. FILL IT OUT and put it in the box with your pieces for sale or hand the form to the person on duty on the White China Stall when exhibition is set up. Make a duplicate for yourself if required.

The Committee reserve the right to reject any item/s deemed not suitable for sale.
